This guide demonstrates how to Setup Push Notification

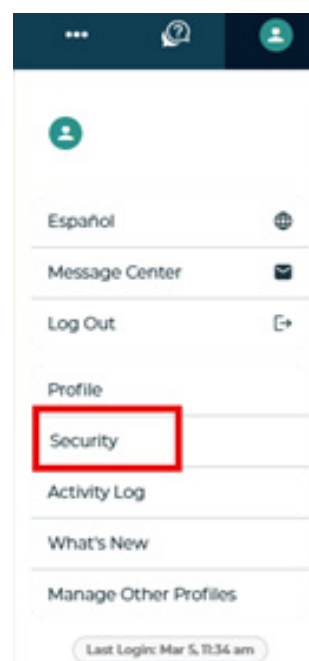
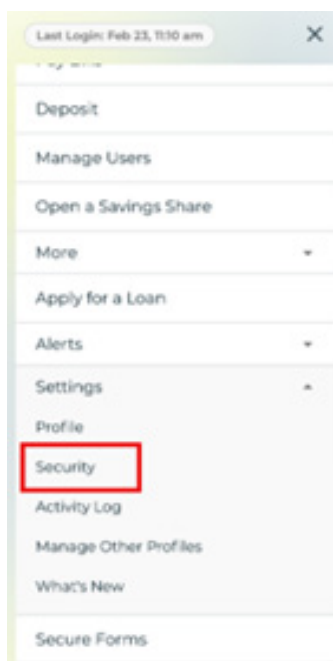
1. Make sure notifications are allowed for the U.S. Eagle app:

- **iPhone:** Settings → Notifications → US Eagle → Allow Notifications
- **Android:** Settings → Apps → US Eagle → Notifications → Allow

2. Open the **U.S. Eagle Mobile Banking App** and sign in.

3. Navigate to Security settings

- For Desktop: Click on User Settings (profile icon) > Security
- For Mobile: Menu > Settings > Security



4. Select Push Authentication.

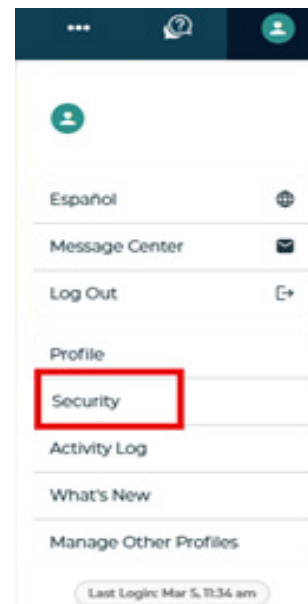
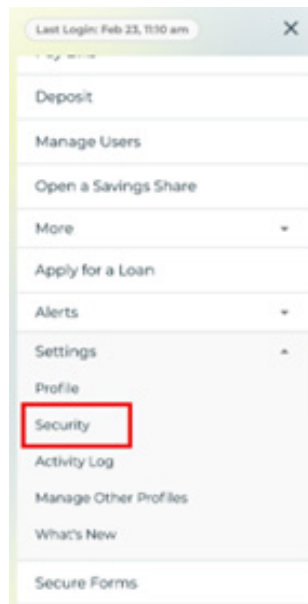
1. Download an authenticator app on your device. Common options include:

- **Google Authenticator**
- **Microsoft Authenticator**

2. Login to **U.S. Eagle Mobile Banking App**

3. Navigate to Security settings

How to Set Up an Authenticator App

7. Choose your setup method:

- **Manual Setup** if you are using one device only
- **QR Code Setup** if you are using a desktop and phone

Manual Setup

7. Copy the **Setup / Secret Key** shown in Digital Banking



8. Open your authenticator app

9. Add a new account and choose the option to **enter a setup key manually.**

10. Enter the setup key and save.

QR Code Setup

7. Open your authenticator app on a second device

8. Add a new account and select **Scan QR Code.**

9. Scan the **QR code shown in Digital Banking**

Finish Setup

11. A 6-digit code will appear in your authenticator app
12. Enter the 6-digit code in Digital Banking
7. Copy the **Setup / Secret Key** shown in Digital Banking

Authenticator App

Download an Authenticator App on your mobile device (iOS and Android), and use it to scan the QR code (barcode) or type the text code provided manually. You may use compatible apps like Google Authenticator, Microsoft Authenticator and Authy.
