APPLICATION CRITERIA

Create a video, essay, podcast, or presentation and showcase your concern for the community.

Do not forget to include the following (not all may apply to every project, but try to be as specific as you can):

- ☐ What specific need did you identify in your community?
- ☐ Why is it important?
- ☐ Who and how many were impacted?
- ☐ What are you doing to solve the problem?
- ☐ What resources were needed and how did you obtain them?
- ☐ How did you raise awareness?
- ☐ If the project has been going on for a while or has been completed, include the results

Bonus: if you created flyers, a website, social media reels, include those to receive bonus points.
