Requirements



- Completed Application. Incomplete applications will <u>not</u> be considered.
- Must be a full-time educator or administrator at a public or charter school in one of the following counties:
 - Bernalillo
 - San Juan
 - Sandoval
 - Santa Fe
 - Valencia
- The school administration must approve all grant requests.
- A brief budget and an explanation of how the funds will be utilized is required.

What is the selection process?

Applications will be reviewed by our Philanthropic committee. Grants will be awarded based on availability, need, number of students served & geographic diversity.
