

URCovered Enrollment - ATM and Debit Card

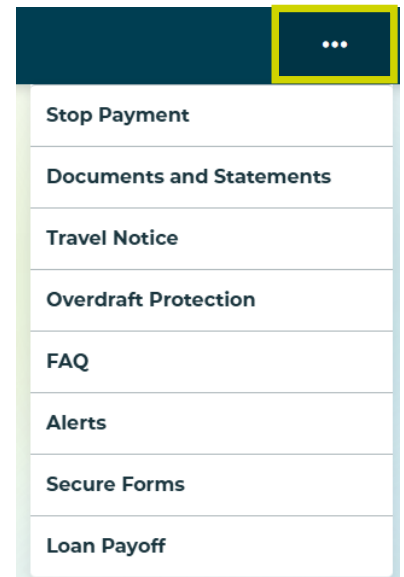
These instructions are to enroll in the additional ATM and Debit Card coverage. Members for over five years are automatically enrolled in URCovered for other transaction types. All other members are enrolled after 90 days.*

Step 1

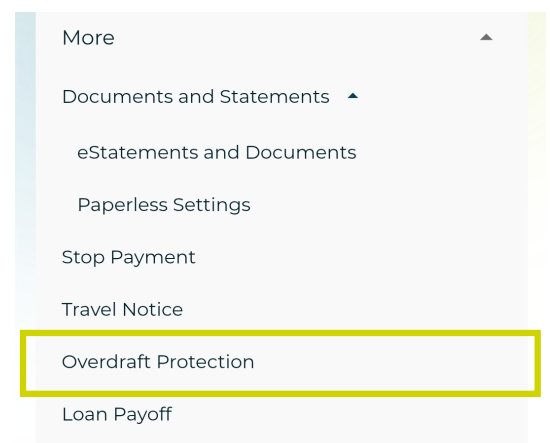
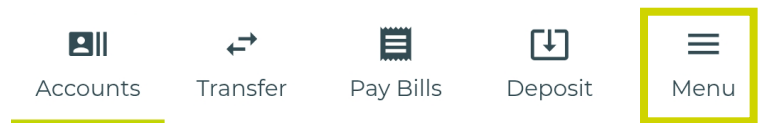
Login to your U.S. Eagle Digital Banking profile.

Step 2

Desktop: Access the menu in the top bar and select “Overdraft Protection”.



Mobile: Select “Menu”, and then select “More” and “Overdraft Protection”.

This option can be turned off at any time. The fee for each transaction is \$0.
