Vigil Bullying Prevention

The 2019 School Crime Supplement (National Center for Education Statistics and Bureau of Justice) indicates that about 20% of students ages 12-18 experienced bullying nationwide. Bullying can happen anywhere and to anyone: youth, adults, at school, at work, and it can occur online, verbally, socially, and physically.

U.S. Eagle has created a scholarship opportunity for students who have actively participated in and/or created effective anti-bullying initiatives in their school or community.

APPLICATION CRITERIA

Submit an essay or video describing an anti-bullying action plan or initiative that you have spearheaded or taken an active role in.

Please include as many of the following items as possible in your submission:

- ☐ A brief background on why you are enthusiastic about the program.
- ☐ A clear description of what action you took.
- ☐ How did you raise awareness? (Include your outreach strategy and optionally attach any outreach materials you may have used).
- ☐ What were the outcomes of your initiative?
- ☐ Was this a one-off campaign or a sustainable long-term initiative?
